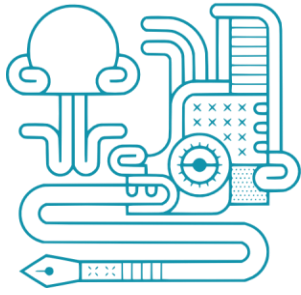

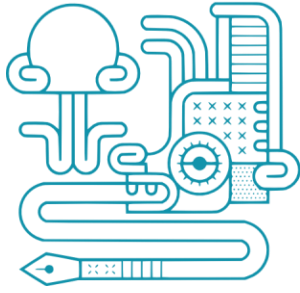

Teachers and books instill the love of reading among 4 to 7 year olds.

### Libros para Todos + Meet the Author Annual Event

---

Bilingual book project for hundreds of children, ages 8 to 12.

### Annual Teen Creative Writing Workshops + Books

---

Full scholarships to attend one or two workshops are awarded to 60 students, ages 13 to 19, with a special interest in writing. They are referred by educators from several local schools.

### Conference Scholarships for Mexican Writers + Teachers

Full and partial scholarships for up to 30 adults.

### Sala Literaria Bellas Artes

Public Reading Room dedicated to Literature & Art, offering programming and books in Spanish and English for local youth and adults.

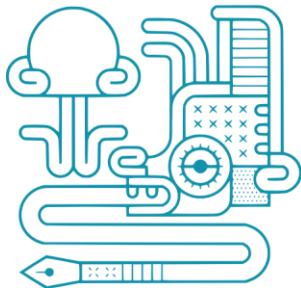
